AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE CONNECTICUT-PUERTO RICO TRADE COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a Connecticut-
- 2 Puerto Rico Trade Commission to (1) advance bilateral trade and
- 3 investment between the state and Puerto Rico, (2) initiate joint action on
- 4 policy issues of mutual interest to the state and Puerto Rico, (3) promote
- 5 business and academic exchanges between the state and Puerto Rico, (4)
- 6 encourage mutual economic support between the state and Puerto Rico,
- 7 (5) encourage mutual investment in the infrastructure of the state and
- 8 Puerto Rico, and (6) address such other related matters as determined
- 9 by the commission.
