AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF THE CONNECTICUT JUVENILE TRAINING SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Children and Families to enter into an agreement with an approved
- 3 nonprofit agency to provide a secure site for the provision of intensive
- 4 mental and behavioral health services to adjudicated high-risk youth
- 5 within the custody of the department.

Statement of Purpose:

To reimagine and reopen the Connecticut Juvenile Training School for the purpose of providing better educational resources for high-risk pretrial offenders and their parents.
