AN ACT REGULATING THE OPERATION OF GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEMS AND NAVIGATION APPLICATIONS IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit persons, firms or
- 2 corporations that operate a global positioning system or mobile
- 3 application that is used for navigation purposes in the state from
- 4 proposing routes that detour heavy motor vehicle traffic from
- 5 established commuter routes onto narrow, local roads without the
- 6 capacity to safely handle such traffic, and (2) require such persons, firms
- 7 or corporations to provide height restrictions on such system or
- 8 application to prevent trucks from crashing into bridges.

Statement of Purpose:

To ease the burden on local roads by prohibiting global positioning systems and navigation applications from redirecting heavy motor vehicle traffic and provide information regarding height restrictions to prevent truck crashes.
