The amendment strikes the language and fiscal impact of sections 10 – 15 in the underlying bill. The amendment results in a revenue gain of \$3 million in FY 26 and FY 27 to the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection for the firefighters cancer relief account. The amendment results in a corresponding total appropriation reduction of \$3 million in FY 26 to the Secretary of the State (\$0.6 million), Department of Administrative Services \$1.75 million), Attorney General's Office (\$0.25 million), Teachers' Retirement Board (\$0.4 million).
