"AN ACT CONCERNING HOUSING GROWTH."

- Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 7-148b of the general statutes, as
- 4 amended by section 1 of public act 25-121, is repealed and the following
- 5 is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2026*):
- 6 (b) Any town, city or borough may, and any town, city or borough
- 7 with a population of twenty-five thousand or more, as determined by
- 8 the most recent decennial census, shall, through its legislative body,
- 9 adopt an ordinance that creates a fair rent commission. Any such
- 10 commission shall make studies and investigations, conduct hearings
- 11 and receive complaints relative to rental charges on housing
- 12 accommodations, except those accommodations rented on a seasonal
- 13 basis, within its jurisdiction, which term shall include mobile
- 14 manufactured homes and mobile manufactured home park lots, in
- 15 order to control and eliminate excessive rental charges on such
- accommodations, and to carry out the provisions of sections 7-148b to

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17 7-148f, inclusive, section 47a-20 and subsection (b) of section 47a-23c.

- 18 The commission, for such purposes, may compel the attendance of
- 19 persons at hearings, issue subpoenas and administer oaths, issue orders
- and continue, review, amend, terminate or suspend any of its orders and
- 21 decisions. The commission may be empowered to retain legal counsel
- 22 to advise it. All hearings conducted pursuant to this section shall be
- open to the public. A prevailing party in a proceeding or action before a
- 24 <u>commissioner shall be awarded attorney's fees by the commission."</u>

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
