Explanation

The bill allows the Department of Consumer Protection to issue a civil penalty of up to \$5,000 for each electronic nicotine delivery system and vapor product sold that violates the provisions of the bill, resulting in a potential revenue gain to the General Fund to the extent violations occur.

The bill also makes various changes regarding dealers of electronic nicotine delivery systems and vapor products which do not have a fiscal impact.

House "A" strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact resulting in the impact described above.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the number of violations.
