Explanation

The bill requires the Auditors of Public Accounts (APA), in conjunction with the Office of Policy and Management, to review the costs of providing certain public and private services to individuals with intellectual disabilities resulting in a cost to the state. To meet the requirements of the bill, the APA will have to hire a consultant to conduct the review and produce the report resulting in a one-time cost in FY 27 of \$50,000 to \$100,000. The exact cost is dependent on responses to the RFP.
