### ***Explanation***

The bill, which allows 16- and 17-year-old learner's permit holders to have their sibling as a passenger during driving instruction in certain circumstances, results in a minimal potential revenue loss to the state from fewer fines.<sup>1</sup>

### ***The Out Years***

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the number of offenses and fines collected.
