Explanation

The bill changes the requirements of the Long-Term Care Planning Committee (LTCPC) within the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) to (1) include a study of certain financing models, best practices, and projected federal support, and (2) remove a requirement to include certain information in studies related to other long-term care related topics. This results in a potential cost to OPM beginning in FY 27 to the extent an additional position is required to complete these studies. The cost is dependent on the level of analysis conducted.

The bill also makes changes to the membership of the LTCPC which does not result in a fiscal impact.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to inflation.
