### REASONS FOR BILL:

HB-5286 proposes that the legislative body of any municipality may establish a program to abate all or a portion of property taxes of the surviving spouse or domestic partner of a police officer, firefighter or emergency medical technician who dies while in the performance of such officers, firefighters, or technician's duties.

This proposed language and revision to the statute would include "domestic partners" to embrace privacy of choice and non-discrimination based on these choices, making an amendment is critical.
