**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR A CULINARY
ARTS CENTER AT ROBERT E. FITCH HIGH SCHOOL IN THE TOWN
OF GROTON.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 seven hundred fifty thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be
- 5 used by the Department of Education for the purpose of providing a
- 6 grant-in-aid to the town of Groton for a culinary arts center at Robert E.
- 7 Fitch High School.
