AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR STAYWELL HEALTH CENTER IN THE CITY OF WATERBURY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 two million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
- 5 Department of Economic and Community Development for the purpose
- 6 of providing a grant-in-aid to StayWell Health Center for technology
- 7 upgrades and capital improvements to the center's facilities in the city
- 8 of Waterbury.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for capital improvements to StayWell Health Center in the city Waterbury.
