AN ACT REQUIRING ANNUAL STATE AGENCY PERFORMANCE PLANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2026*) (a) As used in this section,
2 "state agency" means any department, board, council, commission,
3 institution or other agency in the executive branch of state government,
4 including, but not limited to, each constituent unit.

5 (b) Not later than July 1, 2027, and annually thereafter, each state
6 agency shall develop and implement a performance plan that outlines
7 the state agency's strategic and operational goals. The Office of Policy
8 and Management shall establish guidelines for such plans and shall
9 provide training and technical assistance in plan development and
10 implementation to state agencies upon request.

11 (c) Not later than January 1, 2028, and annually thereafter, each state
12 agency shall report on the state agency's performance plan and its
13 progress in attaining the strategic and operational goals established in
14 the state agency's plan developed pursuant to subsection (b) of this
15 section during the prior year to the Office of Policy and Management,

16 and shall concomitantly submit a copy of such report to the joint
17 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of such
18 agency, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
19 statutes. The Office of Policy and Management shall institute regular
20 performance evaluations of state agencies concerning their progress
21 toward attaining the goals outlined in their performance plans and such
22 evaluations shall occur not less than every two years.

23 (d) After receipt of a report submitted under subsection (c) of this
24 section, each joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
25 cognizance of any state agency that issued a report under subsection (c)
26 of this section shall hold a hearing where the executive authority, as
27 defined in section 4-37e of the general statutes, of the state agency shall
28 present the state agency's performance plan.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require executive branch state agencies to develop and implement annual performance plans.
