



**Senate Bill No. 370**

**Public Act No. 26-115**

***AN ACT CONCERNING THE HOURLY COMPENSATION FOR  
ADJUNCT FIRE INSTRUCTORS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2026*) Commencing July 1, 2026, and each fiscal year thereafter, the Commissioner of Administrative Services shall adjust the hourly compensation for adjunct fire instructors employed by the Connecticut Fire Academy at the same percentage rate as any general wage increase and cost-of-living adjustment included within the most recently ratified agreement between the state and the State Employees Bargaining Agent Coalition.
