"AN ACT ESTABLISHING CONNECTICUT VACCINE STANDARDS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) No physician licensed
4 pursuant to chapter 370 of the general statutes who accepts a patient's
5 refusal to be administered any vaccine on any of the recommended
6 schedules for immunization that are incorporated into the standard of
7 care for immunization established pursuant to section 19a-7f of the
8 general statutes, as amended by this act, shall be liable to (1) such patient
9 for civil damages for any personal injuries that result from such patient's
10 refusal to be administered such vaccine, or (2) any other person for civil
11 damages for any personal injuries that result from such patient's refusal
12 to be administered such vaccine."
