"AN ACT ESTABLISHING CONNECTICUT VACCINE STANDARDS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2027*) No insurer, health care
4 center, hospital service corporation, medical service corporation,
5 fraternal benefit society or other entity that delivers, issues for delivery,
6 renews, amends or continues an individual or group health insurance
7 policy providing coverage of the type specified in subdivisions (1), (2),
8 (4), (11) and (12) of section 38a-469 of the general statutes in this state on
9 or after January 1, 2027, shall rescind, cancel or otherwise terminate
10 coverage of any covered person solely on the basis that such covered
11 person's treating health care provider deviated from the standard of

12 care established pursuant to section 19a-7f of the general statutes, as
13 amended by this act, in the treatment of such covered person."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
