**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING CONNECTICUT VACCINE STANDARDS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) No employer shall discharge  
4 or in any way retaliate, discriminate or take any adverse action against  
5 any employee who does not receive a vaccine that is in any of the  
6 recommended schedules for immunization that is incorporated into the  
7 standard of care for immunization established pursuant to section 19a-  
8 7f of the general statutes, as amended by this act."
