"AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL CAMP SAFETY."

- 2 Strike lines 64 to 67, inclusive, in their entirety, and insert the
- 3 following in lieu thereof:
- 4 "details concerning (1) the physical environment and types of
- 5 facilities and settings in which each such camp operates, (2) the number
- 6 and age range of children served by each such camp in the prior
- 7 calendar year, (3) the number of individuals employed by each such
- 8 camp in the prior calendar year, (4) each such camp's operating
- 9 schedule, including the dates during which children attended each such
- 10 camp in the prior calendar year, (5) whether each such camp requires
- 11 employees to receive training in emergency first aid or
- 12 cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and, if so, how often such training is
- 13 required, (6) whether each such camp authorizes employees to

14 administer medication to children and offers training to employees
15 concerning the administration of medication, (7) whether each such
16 camp accepts child care assistance subsidy payments, (8) whether each
17 such camp maintains written policies and procedures concerning
18 employee hiring and training or the safety and maintenance of facilities
19 and equipment, (9) whether each such camp conducts criminal
20 background checks on prospective or current employees, and (10) the
21 extent to which each such camp's written policies and procedures
22 comport with regulatory requirements pertaining to youth camps, as
23 defined in section 19a-420 of the general statutes, licensed by the Office
24 of Early Childhood."
