SB 308

AN ACT REQUIRING BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO POST CURRICULUM ONLINE.

SUMMARY

Current law requires each local or regional board of education to post the objectives, scope, and sequence of the school district's approved curriculum on the board's website starting with that for the 2026-27 school year (which begins on July 1, 2026). The bill expands the requirement so that boards must begin posting all approved curriculum beginning in the same year.

By law, unchanged by the bill, school boards must make the curriculum and all associated curriculum materials available for inspection in keeping with the federal Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment, which gives parents and guardians the right to inspect instructional material used by the school district as part of their student's educational curriculum (excluding academic tests and assessments).
