
OLR Bill Analysis

sSB 411 (File 309, as amended by Senate "A")*

AN ACT CONCERNING STATE POLICE ASSIGNED TO HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

SUMMARY

This bill changes who decides what the salaries are for sworn members of the State Police who are assigned to a Department of Transportation (DOT)-administered highway construction project. Under current law, these members' salaries are fixed by the Department of Administrative Services commissioner. The bill instead requires (1) the DOT and Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection (DESPP) commissioners to enter into an agreement, within 30 days after the bill passes, regarding the salaries and (2) for these members to be paid the salaries established under the agreement, starting on the agreement's effective date.

*Senate Amendment "A" adds the requirement that the DOT and DESPP commissioners enter into the above agreement.
