The amendment results in the following:

Sections 501 and 502 are not anticipated to have a fiscal impact. These sections make changes related to the voluntary surrender of firearms and require the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection (DESPP) to provide related notification and guidance. It is expected that DESPP and municipal police departments can incorporate the requirements of the amendment into current operations.

Section 503 results in potential minimal revenue loss to local firearms permitting authorities to the extent they fail to complete their duties within existing statutorily established timeframes and must issue refunds. Local permitting authorities are either a chief of police or the chief executive officer of the town.

Other changes in the amendment are clarifying or otherwise do not have a fiscal impact.
