Cost

The amendment requires the Department of Public Health to develop training materials regarding bias toward unvaccinated patients to be distributed to all licensed physicians, resulting in a cost of less than \$10,000 to the agency in FY 27. There may be additional costs associated with printing and postage expenses if training materials cannot be delivered electronically.
