Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact resulting in the following impact.

The amendment makes it an unfair trade practice enforced solely by the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) for health care providers or veterinarians to offer certain financing options to patients resulting in no fiscal impact to the state because the OAG has the expertise and resources to meet the requirements of the amendment.
