OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment allows certain dental hygienists to provide services in private residences without a dentist's general supervision, resulting in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities. The Department of Public Health has the necessary expertise to adopt regulations as required by the amendment.
