Minimal Cost

The amendment results in a minimal cost to the Department of Agriculture (DoAg) associated with inspecting any producer that operates as a rabbit processing facility. DoAg currently performs inspections for chickens, ducks and turkeys, and can add rabbits for a minimal cost to the agency.
