The amendment adds Sections 501 - 504 to the underlying bill and results in the following:

Sections 501 - 503 make changes related to the state's civil preparedness plan and municipal emergency operations plans and do not have a fiscal impact.

Section 504 broadens the potential locations where the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection must establish a police training center from Central Connecticut State University to any institution within Connecticut State Colleges and Universities. This does not result in a fiscal impact because the amendment does not change the anticipated cost or alter available funding for this project.
