OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment strikes section 6 of the underlying bill and creates new requirements for facilities that are licensed by the Department of Children and Families (DCF), resulting in a cost reduction of \$250,000 to DCF associated with out-of-home care location security assessments. This also eliminates potential significant costs to the agency if they were to be responsible for identified security improvements, as well as the potential to incur significant liabilities if they failed to address them.

The potential cost to various municipal police departments related to performing the security assessment in conjunction with DCF is also eliminated by the amendment.
