**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE UNIFORM INVESTIGATION OF
ACCIDENT REPORT AND CERTAIN REPORTS BY PEACE
OFFICERS."**

1 Strike section 2 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 2. Section 7-294pp of the general statutes is amended by adding
3 subsection (e) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2026*):

4 (NEW) (e) Not later than thirty days after an incident when a person
5 experiences an emergency medical condition or is medically unstable
6 while in direct audio or visual contact with, or under the custody or
7 control of, a peace officer, such peace officer, except a United States
8 marshal or deputy marshal, any special agent of the federal government
9 authorized to enforce the provisions of Title 21 of the United States Code
10 or any person employed by the Department of Mental Health and
11 Addiction Services appointed as a special policeman under section 29-
12 18 of the general statutes, shall complete a report describing such
13 incident. Such peace officer shall, if requested by such person, provide
14 a copy of the completed report to the person not later than five days

15 after the report is completed."
