**AN ACT CONCERNING THE HOURLY COMPENSATION FOR
ADJUNCT FIRE INSTRUCTORS**

SUMMARY: This act requires the Department of Administrative Services commissioner, beginning July 1, 2026, and every fiscal year after, to adjust each Connecticut Fire Academy adjunct fire instructor's hourly compensation by the same percentage as the general wage increase and cost-of-living adjustment included in the most recently ratified agreement between the state and the State Employees Bargaining Agent Coalition.

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2026
