

**The Department of Veterans Affairs  
Levitow Lane and Building 51**

The Department of Veterans Affairs is in the final stages of renovation of several housing units on our campus. The renovations will be completed before July 1, 2026, and ready for occupancy. The units will offer temporary housing for veterans and their families who are at risk of homelessness and to meet the needs of military personnel and their families who are either preparing for or returning from deployment. The Department of Veterans Affairs is requesting \$115,157 in Personal Services (10010) funding and \$365,344 in Other Expenses (10020) funding to support these programs.

In addition to the housing units, wrap-around services will be provided. Our team of social workers, employment specialist, Licensed Professional Counselor and medical personnel are adept at creating Individual recovery plans and work with the veterans to achieve their goals whether that be permanent housing, employment or psychosocial needs. At the completion of this project, we will be able to positively impact veterans and their families in transition like those serving in Connecticut National Guard.

The agency is requesting the addition of 2 staff members to provide support services. We would have a Residential Facility Worker on site for the second and third shift. We would use a Veteran Worker 20 hours per week to provide janitorial services in the common areas of the building, and Chrysalis will provide case management services.
