



Separation by Type Thousands through March 2013










U.S. Projected Employment Change



Change in Employment 2010 to 2020










CT Occupations with Most Openings

Projected 2010 to 2020 Average Annual Openings

















Age Groups





Connecticut Population 2000 vs. 2010






