I HAVE BEEN IN THE FACILITIES OF CORRIGAN FOR A FEW MONTHS NOW AND, I'VE COME TO EXPERIENCE BELOW-NORMAL HEAT TEMPERATURES. MY CELL IS UNCONTROLLABLY COLD. THIS AFFECTS MY SLEEP AND MOOD. STAFF ARE AWARE OF THIS BUT NO POSITIVE ACTIONS HAVE RESULTED. I FEEL LIKE

I AM NOT BEING TREATED AS A HUMAN BEING.

I AM A U.S. CITIZEN WHO HAS MERELY MADE WRONG CHOICES, OR AM ACCUSED OF SUCH. THE ABOVE DESCRIBED INDIFFERENCES SHOULD NOT BE IMPAIRED ON ME NOR OTHERS.

- MORE POSTS FOR CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS WITHIN THE FACILITY TO FACILITATE INMATE NEEDS AND CONCERNS. STAFF ARE USUALLY OVERWORKED AND STREACHED THIN WHERE IT TAKES FOREVER TO ACCOMPLISH ANYTHING. THERE SHOULD BE COUNCILORS FOR EVERY BLOCK TO ADDRESS NEEDS AND CONCERNS ESPECIALLY OF LEGAL MATTERS.
