To whom it may concern,

I'm an inmate incarcerated at Willard - Cybulski C.I. My peers and I struggle with the Favoritism granted to the "Program dorms" here at Cybulski.

The "program dorms" are given more "privileges" than the non-program dorms. The Facility sees our access to cleanliness as a "privilege".

I was recently moved out of one of the "program dorms" for protesting this unfair treatment. I'm now back in one of the non-"program dorms".

In the "program dorms" we are allowed access to cleaning products whenever we need them. We are allotted a full day to deep clean the unit on a monthly basis. We have access to paper towels, scrub brushes, clean mop heads, a floor buffer, and fans to dry the floor. The bathroom and dayroom are cleaned daily.

In the non-"program dorms" the floors go without being mopped for days on end, we are without cleaning products for many days at a time, the bathrooms are nearly unusable due to fecal matter on surfaces, a constant rancid odour, clogged urinals and toilets, and much more.

The two non-program dorms I've lived in were both this way. From what my peers tell me, they are all this way. My peers in the program dorms that I've not been in describe their experience just as mine was before I was removed.

I've been at other prisons in my 20 months as a CTDOC inmate (Garner, NHCC, Walker), but none were quite this corrupt.

I've been waiting on a list for an MRI for well over a year with no news. I've been waiting on a list for well over a year for a dental X-ray. I've been waiting to see the podiatrist for two plus months with no news as well. I'm twenty-two years old, and I must sit back and watch as my body falls apart. I want to look forward to living a successful life when I get out, but will be unable to do so if I no longer have my good health. Before coming to prison I was in Bi-weekly physical therapy for a broken spine, broken arm, broken hand and sprained elbow. Once arrested I received no help for my ailments.
