I've Been dealing with the Medical Department At Cheshire for a Skin Condition That I did not have until I was Transferred to this Facility When I first Reported it to medical they told me that there was nothing wrong with me and told me to write mental health because it told them that my skin itched and felt like it was Burn and that there was something wrong and that not how you deal with a medical tell them to write a Request to Mental Health Then I was put on the Doctors list to be seen and once I seen the doctor I was told that I had some kind Rash and was put on a few different kinds of medication with NO resolve then in November of 2025 I was put on the list for the UConn Dermatologist which was Rescheduled 3 time Before I was seen By ~~DER~~ Dermatologist Department Almost a year Later Before I was Recommended a treatment for my Skin condition so I was made to suffer in pain with my skin condition with symptoms of Red skin, Burning skin and very itchy skin I should not had to suffer like and told there was nothing they could do for me that I have to wait until I see the Dermatologist when ever I'm scheduled to be seen and the Medical Neglect is unprofessional and we should be receiving medical care equalled to community standards which we receive far from that and very unprofessional.

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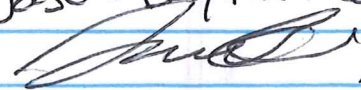
There are a Number of Problems At Cheshire CT from Medical Department to The lack of Proper Maintenance and up keep of the facility in the South Side, South Block 3 There are leaks in the Sealing in a few Place and have Been That way Since I Transferred to This Facility on June 4, 2025 and has Not Been Fixed so when it RAINS they Put Buckets and Blankets on the floors ~~and~~ ^{and} ~~both~~ ^{BOTH} the Shower on the Top Tier only has 2 Working Showers The 3rd one has Been Broken for over The year that I've Been in This facility and The Bottom Tier shower is dirty with Bugs and little worms All over the Room and a Broken Pipe in the Back Locked Access AREA to the Showers for maintenance That Been Leaking for over a year with Black mold All over the Access AREA with a Pond of unsanitary Black molded water on the floor and it very unsanitary Shower condition that would Lead to problem health condition for everyone and it seem Like maintenance drags there feet any time something Need to Be fixed or doesnt ever get fixed and medical Drag there feet see anyone that Really Need ~~to~~ ^{to be} seen like you have to Beg and write 3-4 Request for sick call and takes a long time to find Treatment for some problems or ~~way~~ to treat you like a Lab Rat With different Medications That don't even Treat the Problem your having and they dont know how to properly diagnose some symptoms or treat them the Kitchen Also has a Numbers of issue with The Bugs and Mice a arand which is a unsanitary

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Conditions for me and food the are not up to par with what the recommended meals should sometime were sent rotten stuff and some stuff should not even ~~be feed~~ be feed to an animal let alone a human Also the water in this facility is unsanitary to be drinking and taste like metal and most times has a beed smell bad and this is the same water they use to make food or have to drink and then the unprofessional way the C/O act towards the offender population they treat us like were the worst scum of the earth and that we should be treated disrespectfully and talk to us any way they feel like it and they way they put us on lock down for no reason every Wednesday either on first shift or second shift which ever time they lock us down well be let out of our cell for 1 hour for that shift for what they call training & every Wednesday for the summer season or football season or its just that C/O don't want to come in that day but I don't believe there that much training needing to be done it just seem like the C/Os want one day outta the week to not have to deal with anything and get paid to do nothing and the air quality in this facility is very unsanitary they never clean the air vents in the cell were we spend most of our day the air that blows out of the cell vents are full of mold, dead skin bad smells because of not being cleaned dust and dust mites and a lot of people end up with the health problems and the medical ~~only~~ only want to treat the symptoms and not the problem This facility is in a grate state of disrepair As with DOC in Genral it just keep going down hill year after year.
