Dear Sir,

I'd like to address some injustices here at Carl Robinson Correctional Institution. These may seem trivial to the general public but to us it most definitely is not.

The following is a list of grievances;

1. Inmates are not given the proper food allotted by the state Dietitian, we are not given dressings for certain pasta's and Salads, Plain diced Cabbage, Plain lettuce. Foods are being replaced often making the combination unappealing. Such as mash potatoes with chilly, baked potatoes with sloppy Joe mix and days old corn bread given as a replacement for breakfast cake.

Often when the last 120 inmates are to be fed they run out of what was served to the rest of the inmates and then substitute with a lesser meal. The overall lax of meal preparation is without a doubt neglectful.

2. There are also unsanitary conditions such as uncovered cups of juice on trays where all inmates are aloud to reach over allowing for there fingers to touch another inmates juice. This is definitely unsanitary. Also in the recent pass black mold was found in the dishwasher, due to the lac of proper cleaning.

3. The Kitchen Supervisory staff is having the inmate cooks preparing State issued food for officers working here. This may be a direct breach of their contract?

Medical here also needs help. I believe that the staff may be over worked, causing certain nurses to lack professional Courtesy. In addition bulk medication is often not given on time, leaving inmates without, Sometimes for several days. Also written requests asking for information on medication or remedies for illnesses are frequently being addressed weeks latter.

This may be our only chance for change.
