Background

The annual salaries for judges are set by statute.¹ From time to time, this statute is amended to alter the salaries that judges receive.²

^{*}In 2016, MSS PA 16-3 passed and increased judicial compensation effective 7/1/17. However, in October of 2017, JSS PA 17-2 passed and reduced the salaries back to the level of FY 16 effective 10/31/17.

Other Impacts

Compensation for constitutional officers is tied to judicial compensation by statute.³ The Governor's salary is that of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court. The Lieutenant Governor, the Treasurer, the Secretary, the Comptroller, and the Attorney General all have the same compensation as a Superior Court Judge. When judicial compensation is altered, the salaries for these offices do not change until after the next election for such offices.

The salary of Workers' Compensation Commission administrative law judges is linked to the salary of a Superior Court judge and is set in CGS § 31-277.

CGS §§ 45a-95 and 45a-95a require that Probate Court judges receive compensation that corresponds to that of a Superior Court judge based upon the "band" that the court is in.
